Why I wish I would have had a PSA test.

This year's prostate cancer awareness week is very special to me because I am 72 and I was just diagnosed with prostate cancer. I spent my career as a teacher of trades. I always wanted my students to be aware of dangers and to be prepared to respond appropriately. But this diagnosis of prostate cancer took me unaware. In spite of all the test and medical procedures that I have had, I never had a PSA test and they are so easy to get. This summer I went to the emergency with severe back pain. As a result, I found out that I have prostate cancer that has spread to my spine. My pain is being controlled and I have started treatments at the cancer centre. I have talked to men at Prostate Cancer Support Thunder Bay and found men who understand what I am going through. They are good listeners, and their experience is helping me in this. My faith in the Lord has carried me through the trouble times and will continue to be there for me. The people at the cancer centre and support group are God's love in action. Still, I wish I would have taken the responsibility and told my doctor that I wanted a PSA test done before it got this far. **Keith Moore**
